- The Tenderers are to submit the ORIGINAL SET of the two part Tender (Both Part-I Technical Bid and Part-II Commercial Bid) duly filled in, attach necessary documents and are advised to retain the duplicate set of documents for their records.
- 3. The Part-1 pre-qualification cum technical bid consisting of page Nos. 1 to 19 and the part-II Commercial bid consisting of page Nos. 1 to 2 should be submitted. The tender documents duly filled can only be submitted by e-tendering through the e-procurement website "http://www.tntenders.gov.in for "Tender for the work of the running of Industrial Canteen at Dairy Cum Powder Plant, Ammapalayam, Thiruvannamalai period for Two year (2022-2024) Twelve (24) months period and is extendable up to six (6) months at the same rate and on the same terms and conditions from the date of expiry of contract by the successful tenderer
- 4. The PART II Commercial Bids shall be opened within 90 days of the opening of the Part I pre-qualification-Technical Bids in the presence of Tenderers or their authorized representative who opt to be present. The date of such opening of Commercial Bid will be informed separately to those who qualify in the PART I Technical Bid.

- 5. Kindly go through the check list given and ensure compliance of the terms and conditions.
- 6. 4. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 4.1 The Contractor should register himself with the appropriate Registration authority of Labour Department, Government of Tamil Nadu, and Chennai-600 006, under Section 7 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition Act 1970.
- 4.2 PAN Card to be produced. Otherwise appropriate rate of tax will be deducted from the bill amount.
- 4.3 EPF Registration Certificate have to be enclosed in Technical Bid documentary.
- 4.4 GST Registration Certificate to be produced.
- 4.5 If the Contractor fails to furnish the E.P.F. payment details with the bills, the bills it will not be settled.
- 4.6 The Contractor should maintain a register of workmen employed by him, muster roll, Wages register etc. and must comply with all the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 and other Labour laws.
- 4.7 The Federation is entitled to deduct contribution payable under EPF Act from the Contractor in respect of the Contract Labour without any prior notice if required.
- 4.8 The Contractor shall discharge all the obligation's cast under
- a) The Tamil Nadu Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970.
- b) Employees Provident Fund Act.
- c) The Tamil Nadu Minimum Wages Act.
- d) Health related Act and other Acts applicable from time to time.
- 4.9 The validity of the Contract is for Two year from the date of execution of work and it is extendable further for another six months in the event of delay in finalisation of new tender.
- 4.10The Contractor has to adopt the procedures as laid down by the Deputy General Manager (Engg), Dairy Cum Powder Plant, Ammapalayam, Thiruvannamalai.
- 4.11The Contractor has to arrange adequate manpower to cook, Store and serve the food stuff to the people at Dairy Cum Powder Plant, Ammapalayam, Thiruvannamalai as per the scope of work.
- 4.12The Contractor should not engage persons below 18 years of age.

- 4.13The Contractor shall be responsible for the discipline of the persons engaged by him for the execution of the work.
- 4.14It is specifically stipulated that the Federation has no connection whatsoever with the employees engaged by the contractor. The Contractor shall be responsible for the discharge of all legal obligations under various labour legislations in force for the persons engaged by him.
- 4.15The Contractor shall be responsible to the TCMPF for any loss or discharge arising out of theft, burglary, pilferage, larceny, mischief, looting etc., due to the involvement and any negligence of his workers and he shall make good any such loss or damage to the Federation and such losses are liable for deduction from contractor bills/deposits etc.
- 4.16The contractor shall indemnify and keep harmless the TCMPF Ltd., from any claim by an employee/workers employed/engaged by him for the purpose under workmen Compensation Act, or Employer's Liability Act or any other acts of such nature respectively in force.
- 4.17The Contractor shall be responsible for the behaviour of his workers or for non compliance of the procedures, suitable penalty will be imposed including cancellation of the agreement.
- 4.18The Contractor should ensure the personal cleanliness and hygiene of the workers engaged by him.
- 4.19All the Contract workers employed by the Contractor will have to undergo medical check up once in 6 months as per the relevant provisions of the Factory Act and take necessary preventive medicines as directed by the Medical Officer. Persons found unfit medically will have to be removed and replacement made immediately.
- 4.20The contractor should provide two sets of uniform to their staff annually at his/her own cost and should ensure that their staff are neat and in uniform while on duty.
- 4.21The contract workers must wear clean uniform, gloves and caps with the name of the company or emblem and identity card issued by the contractor while on duty for easy identification.

- 4.22 The contractor and his/her workers should be courteous while on duty for easy identification
- 4.23 A committee consisting of TCMPF employees will inspect the premises for cleanliness and hygiene. They will taste and suggest improvements for the stuff prepared. All improvements in the day to day operations will be suggested by the Committee. The Contractor has to coordinate with the Committee in all respects.
- 4.24 In the event of any dispute, between the contractor and his/her Staff, the Contractor is solely responsible to settle the issue.
- 4.25 a) Penalty amount of Rs.500/- for the first default and double the penalty for the subsequent defaults will be imposed for violation of any of the terms and conditions. The contract will be terminated at the discretion of the Federation for the third default.
 b) In case the contractor is unable to engage the required No. of employees due to any reason, for satisfactory completion of the work, the loss suffered by the Federation, on account of his such failure, and as ascertained by the Federation, shall be made good by the Contractor, forthwith.

c) If the contractor is found to be blacklisted or terminated in any other contract with the Federation/District Unions, the Federation reserves the right to terminate the contract.

- 4.26 If the contractor fails to execute the contract work as stipulated in the annexure, satisfactorily at the contract rate throughout the contract period, the Security Deposit will be forfeited in full by the Federation.
- 4.27 The Contractor shall be liable to forfeiture of Security Deposit and penalty at the rate quoted. If on any occasion the production is affected due to not running canteen and go slow by the workers etc. because of non functioning of canteen
- 4.28 In case of dispute, the Deputy Registrar (Dairying) Court, Tiruvallure alone shall have jurisdiction.
- 4.29 a) If the Contractor use the water, electricity etc. unnecessarily, fine will be imposed @ Rs.50/- per instance over and above the recovery of excess use beyond the free supply.

b) The cleanliness and hygiene in and around the canteen area will be the responsibility of the Contractor. If any lapses or noticed, a fine of Rs.50/- will be imposed. In addition to the fine the contractor has to do the works.

- 4.30 The Managing Director, TCMPF Limited reserves the right to terminate the contract without assigning any reason thereof. The decision shall be final and binding.
- 4.31 The food items should be supplied daily with good quality for a period of one year if the Federation decides, the contract will be extended for further period of three months.

4.32 Food Items to be supplied daily

- 4.33 The signatory of the tenderer should indicate his/her/their status in which he/she/they have signed and submit necessary Legally/Lawfully admissible documentary proof in respect of such authority assigned to him/her/them by the firm. If the tender opening day is declared as a holiday, the tenders shall be received and opened immediately on the next working day at the same time and place.
- 4.34 In case of any accident involving the employees of the successful Tenderer the compensation and the penal consequences under the relevant Act shall be borne entirely by the successful Tenderer. If the Federation has to incur any expenditure in that regard, the same shall be reimbursed by the successful Tenderer
- 4.35 The employees so engaged by the successful Tenderer under no circumstances could be considered for appointment in the Federation on the ground that they have worked as Contract Labourer.

- 4.36 The employees of the successful Tenderer can not claim any benefits or amenities extended to Federation employees.
- 4.37 The successful Tenderer, after the expiry of the contract period has to execute the work at the same rate, terms and conditions for a period up to three months from the date of expiry of the contract. if any required by the Federation .
- 4.38 The successful Tenderer shall be responsible to the TCMPF for any loss or damage arising out of theft, burglary, pilferage, larceny, mischief, looting etc. due to the involvement or negligence of his/her workers and the successful Tenderer shall make good any such losses or damages as ascertained by the Federation and such losses are liable for deduction from his/her bills/deposits etc.
- 4.39 If the successful Tenderer defaults to execute agreement or to pay security or to supply ordered quantity either in part or full shall be debarred from participating in the subsequent Tender for a period of three years.
- 4.40 The Tenderer should quote their rates for running of Canteen at Dairy Cum Powder Plant, Ammapalayam, Thiruvannamalai in a separate commercial bid.

PAYMENT OF EMD

- 4.41 The tenderer should pay an EMD amount of Rs.79,000/- (Rupees Seventy Nine thousand only). The above said EMD shall be remitted online only before the closure date and time as specified.
- 4.42 If, the tenderer claiming exemption from the payment of Earnest Money Deposit, should furnish necessary valid documentary proof for SSI registration in the form of Entrepreneurs Memorandum EM No. Part - I and Part - II as per new system and its accessories MSMED Act 2006 of Tamilnadu Small Industries Development Corporation / the District Industries centre of Directorate of Industries and Commerce for the tenderers from Tamilnadu or NSIC certificate for the tenderers from other states in respect of those items for which the registration certificate has been obtained and tenders called for by the Federation.
- 4.43 The tender document either without EMD as mentioned in Sl.No.4.41 or the claim of exemption as mentioned in Sl.No4.42 will be summarily rejected.
- 4.44 The EMD remitted by the Tenderer shall be forfeited in full and the offer will be summarily rejected in the following contingencies.
 - i) If the Tenderer withdraws his offer or backs out before the expiry of the validity period or after acceptance of the tender
 - ii) If the Tenderer revises any of the terms quoted after opening the Tender.

SIGNATURE OF THE TENDERER.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- 4.45 A Security Deposit @ 5% of the work value (including EMD) should be paid on receipt of the orders from the Federation. The Security deposit amount will be refunded only after the expiry of six months from the date of completion of the contract after issuance of Certificate by the Deputy General Manager (Engg) that the contract has been executed satisfactorily.
- 4.46 The EMD paid already along with the tender shall be adjusted against the security deposit to be paid by the successful tenderer.
- 4.47 No exemption will be given from payment of Security Deposit under any circumstances as per TNTT Act and the same should be remitted by Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque from any Nationalized/ commercial Bank in favour of "The Deputy General Manager (Engg), DCPP, Ammapalayam "
- 4.48 The Security Deposit is liable to be adjusted against any loss or damage caused by the contractor to the Federation by violation of the tender condition.
- 4.49 The Security deposit will be refunded only after the expiry of 6 months from the date of satisfactory completion of the contract and satisfactorily complying with the scope of work and terms and conditions thereof.
- 4.50 No interest shall be paid for the Earnest Money Deposit or Security Deposit.

AGREEMENT

4.51 The successful contractor shall execute an agreement on Rs.100/stamp paper incorporating the terms and conditions of the contract and scope of work within 10 days from the date of intimation of the acceptance of the order. In case of default of either of these conditions (i.e.) remitting the Security Deposit and execution of the agreement (within the time allowed), the E.M.D. paid will be forfeited.

5. PRE - QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- 5.1 The Tenderer should have minimum of One year experience in running of an Industrial Canteen in any of the Industries or any other Organisations within the last 3 years from the date of Notice Inviting Tender. Evidence such as work order and performance report must be enclosed.
- 5.2 The tender document either without EMD as mentioned in Sl.No.4.41 or the claim of exemption as mentioned in Sl.No4.42 will be summarily rejected.
- 5.3 Tenderer should submit current EPF registration certificate, PAN card and GST Certificate attested by the Notary Public.
- 5.4 The Federation reserves the right to reject the offer of a Tenderer who had either been black-listed or charged for non performance of work either in part or full in the Federation previously during the last 3 years.
- 5.5 The tender will be evaluated as per TNTT Act.
- 5.6 All inclusive end rate shall be considered for evaluation of lowest offer.
- 5.7 All the tenderers who are qualified in the Technical bid have to prepare the samples of food menu at Dairy Cum Powder Plant, Canteen as prescribed by the Management on any of the date said by the Committee before opening the Commercial bid. The food samples are to be served to the committee at the venue as intimated by the Management.
- 5.8 The food samples will be evaluated by the committee on basis of the sample evaluation only opening of their commercial bid will be considered.
- 5.9 Management reserves the right not to open the Commercial bid of any of the tenderers who fail in the food samples evaluation.

6.TERMS OF PAYMENT

- 6.1 The Contractor shall submit his monthly bill in triplicate for payment on the 1st of succeeding month, along with Xerox copies of challans and EPF remittance details and on satisfactory performance.
- 6.2 The payment will be made within 15 days from the date of receipt of the bill.
- 6.3 The contractor shall disburse wages to the workers working under the control every month as per the rules in force. He has to furnish the details of disbursement of wages to his workers to the DGM. (Engg), Dairy Cum Powder Plant, Ammapalayam on demand.
- 6.4 Applicable rate of Income tax will be deducted from the monthly bill of the successful Tenderer and the same will be remitted to the Income Tax Department.
- 6.5 The Tenderer should produce all original documents for verification, copies of which were submitted during the evaluation of Part I Technical Bids, when called for.
- 6.6 Loss or damage if any caused by the successful Tenderer to the Federation shall be adjusted against the bill amount

7. VALIDITY

- 7.1 The Tender shall be kept for acceptance for a period 180 days from the date of opening of Part I Technical Bid. The offers with lower validity period are liable for rejection.
- 7.2 The Tenderer shall agree to extend the validity of the bids without altering the substance and prices of their bid for further period, if any required by Federation.

8.VIOLATION OF CONTRACT

- 8.1 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Tender schedule, no obligation is cast on the Federation to accept the lowest Tenderer and the Federation shall also have the right to accept or reject the tender without assigning any reasons.
- 8.2 For violation of any of the terms and conditions of the contract, the Federation reserves the right to terminate the contract with or without notice, as applicable.
- 8.3 In the event of termination of contract, the SD will be forfeited and any of the resultant loss shall be recovered from pending bills

9. LEGAL JURISDICTION.

- 9.1 The successful Tenderer shall become an Associate Member of TCMPF Ltd. by paying the requisite fees under the Tamil Nadu Cooperative Societies Act & Rules.
- 9.2 If either party is in any way aggrieved, that party has the right to raise dispute by way of Arbitration under Section 90 of the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies Act before the Dy.Registrar(Dairying) Thiruvallur whose decision shall be accepted as final.
- 9.3 In case of dispute, the relevant court in Chennai alone will have jurisdiction.

15 **10. SCOPE OF WORK**

- 10.1 The Contractor has to accept the terms and conditions as laid down by the TCMPF Limited and also ensure that quality standards are followed as laid down by TCMPF Limited.
- 10.2 The Contractor should run the canteen "round" the clock basis with limited service for night shift on all days. The Factory functions in the following shifts
 - a) First shift from 6.00 to 14.00 Hours.
 - b) Second Shift from 14.00 to 22.00 Hours.
 - c) Third Shift from 22.00 Hours to 06.00 Hours.
 - d) General Shift from 09.00 to 17.30 Hours.
- 10.3 The Management will supply 2,000 liters of water, 50 Units of Electricity, and 15 liters of Milk per day free of cost for the supply of estimated quantity of tea, and meals. Any consumption over and above 2,000 liters of water, 50 Units of Electricity and 15 liters of Milk per day will have to be paid by the Contractor to the Management at the rate to be specified by TCMPF Limited.
- 10.4 The Contractor has to supply the food items listed in the annexure at minimum quoted price on a regular basis every day.
- 10.5 The items mentioned in the annexure are to be supplied at the following timing at the minimum rates quoted for the TCMPF Limited, Employees (workers/Staff and officers)

a) Breakfast	from 06.00 to 10.00 Hours.
b) Morning snacks	from 10.00 to 11.00 hours
c) Lunch	from 12.00 to 13.00 Hours for "A" shift workers
	from 13.00 to 15.00 Hours for "G" shift workers,
	Office Staff and Officers.
d) Evening snacks	from 16.00 to 18.00 Hours.
e) Night	from 20.00 to 22.00 Hours.

- 10.6 The contractor should make necessary arrangements to provide the catering facilities of the items mentioned in the annexure to the employees of TCMPF Limited on all days of the tender period including Bundh days, Hartal days if any and even on natural calamity days unless and otherwise it is declared not necessary by the Federation.
- 10.7 No revision of rate will be entertained at any cost during the tender period.

- 10.8 There should not be any case of non availability of any of the items mentioned in the annexure as per timings.
- 10.9 The Contractor will have to make necessary arrangements to prepare the food stuff hygienically with good taste and serve to the employees. Any complaint regarding quality of food supplied will be decided by a Committee appointed by the Management.
- 10.10 The Contractor shall prepare, serve vegetarian food only.
- 10.11 A Notice indicating the Menu quantity and Price chart is to be displayed in the Canteen Notice Board, daily.
- 10.12 The Contractor shall engage sufficient manpower for smooth functioning of the Canteen as detailed below.
 - a) One Canteen Supervisor
 - b) Skilled cook with one Assistant.
 - c) Two Counter Assistants for supplying food items.
 - d) Separate Assistant for collecting used plates, cups, cleaning tables /floor etc. He/She should not be engaged in Kitchen or at food Distribution counter.
 - e) Separate Assistant should be engaged for cleaning utensils and Plates.
- 10.13 All Canteen Staff should wear clean Uniform, apron mouthpiece, gloves etc.
- 10.14 The Contractor should maintain clean sanitary environment in the Kitchen and Catering area. Wet cleaning should be done daily (Twice) to maintain hygienic.
- 10.15 The Contractor should make his own arrangement for the supply of gas required for cooking purpose at his own cost.
- 10.16 Snacks items like salt biscuit, Bonda, Samosa, vada, Sajji, Puffs, Chenna sundal, etc., to be supplied at the rates decided by the contractor and collected as cash and carry basis.
