CORRIGENDUM

(A copy of authenticated corrigendum to be enclosed along with Part-I Technical bid)

The following amendments were made towards the purchase of 16,325 MT of Multi-layer Co-extruded Poly End Film to Federation and all DCMPUs for three years (2022-2025) as detailed below:

TECHNICAL BID

1) Page No.9

4.7.4 Any tenderer claiming exemption from the payment of EMD, should enclose necessary valid documentary proof in respect of SSI Units located in the State of Tamilnadu for SSI registration in the form of entrepreneurs memorandum (EM) No. Part-I and Part-II as per new system and other accessories MSMED Act 2006 of Tamilnadu Small Industries Development Corporation / the District industries centre of directorate of industries and commerce in respect of those items manufactured by them for which the registration certificate has been obtained and tenders called for by the Federation. (Or) In respect of SSI Units located outside the state(Tamilnadu), such of these units registered with NSIC in respect of items manufactured by them for which tenders have been called for alone will be granted exemption from payment of EMD. (Or) In respect of SSI Units located within/outside the state(Tamilnadu), such of these units registered with Udyog Aadhaar/Udyam Registration Certificate in respect of items manufactured by them for which tenders have been called for, and the production capacity not less than 25% of the tendered quantity alone will be granted exemption from payment of EMD.

by them for which tenders have been called for alone will be granted exemption from payment of EMD. (Or) In respect of SSI Units located **within** the state(Tamilnadu), such of these units registered with Udyog Aadhaar/Udyam Registration Certificate in respect of items manufactured by them for which tenders have been called for, and the production capacity not less than 25% of the tendered quantity alone will be granted exemption from payment of EMD.

7.9 FINANCIAL: The tenderer shall have average annual sales turn-over for the last three financial years equal to the value of the tenderer's offered quantity per annum (or) minimum annual sales turn-over in each of the last three financial years shall not be less than 50% of the value of tenderers offered quantity per annum. The value of tenderer's offered quantity shall be arrived by multiplying tenderer's offered quantity per annum with tender estimated value of Rs.2,09,208.10/- per MT (based on granule price as on 10.03.2022) of poly end film. The financial statement for the last three financial years attested by Chartered Accountant shall be enclosed in the Technical Bid.

7.10.1 Each tender should be accompanied with One No. of three colours minimum printed film sample with any design and One No. of plain film sample in not less than 5 Kgs. in weight in each category micron film tendered for 55 Micron 500ml - two samples, 55 Micron 1000ml - two samples & 110 Micron 5 litre - two samples in not less than 10 Kgs. in weight thus coming to totally six in opaque white pigmented only. **Tender** sample roll should be printed with the name of the manufacturing firm so as to identify the company sample without this, the tender will be rejected. However, plain opaque film should not have any marking/print. The tenderer who has downloaded the tender documents can receive the samples film rolls from this office on request. The tenders received without samples as described above will be summarily rejected. The tenderers should submit their tender offers along with the samples to the Dy. Genl. The name of the firm to be marked by permanent marker or to be mentioned in the sticker in the inner core of the plain film sample roll and another sample roll with eye mark should be printed with the name of the manufacturing firm so as to identify the company sample without this,

the tender will be rejected. However, plain opaque film should not have any marking/print. The tenderer who has downloaded the tender documents can receive the samples film rolls from this office on request.
