The following amendments were made towards the work contract for milk sachets checking, stacking in tubs, Transporting tubs to cold rooms for storage, Transporting tubs from cold rooms to despatch dock, Loading into the vehicles, Leak milk sachet segregation, Cleaning of Floor areas near machine, Conveyor, Cold rooms and Despatch dock daily for three shifts at Ambattur Dairy, Chennai – 98 for 12 months for the year 2022-2023.
